Introduction of the new EU-funded project

On 25 November 2016, Centre of Excellence in EU Matters organized kick-off event of the new EU funded project. The ceremony was leaded by rector Hafiz Pashaev, of ADA University, Ambassador Malena Mard, EU Delegation, Mr. Vasilis

The 14 months project "Support to establishment of EU Studies Programme at ADA University" has commenced its activities since 1 August 2016. The project is implemented in consortium with the Kaunas Technological University and other leading European universities.

The overall goal is to enhance the EU knowledge in Azerbaijan across various sectors and government institutions all over the country for better understanding of and cooperation with the European Union.

On 24 October 2016 President of Croatia, H.E. Kolinda Grabar-Kitarović, visited ADA University and gave a speech to ADA University students and faculty on bilateral relations between Azerbaijan and Croatia within the framework of her official visit to Azerbaijan.

Course on on mediation and communication skills



On 20-24 September 2016 the Centre of Excellence in EU Studies at ADA University together with DAAD Informationszentrum Baku organized a four-day course for Azerbaijani civil servants focusing on mediation and communication skills. The

course was led by Dr. Stenner, a certified German mediator with extensive academic and practical experience in the filed of mediation

and negotiation. Dr. Stenner used experiential learning methodology to broaden the skills and experiences of Azerbaijani civil servants in communication and conflict resolution.

Workshop "Prospects and Challenging of Developing EU Studies"



On 25 November 2016 the Center of Excellence in EU Studies at ADA University hosted the workshop entitled "Prospects and Challenging of Developing EU Studies" within the framework of the new EU-funded project: "Support to Establishment of MA EU Studies Programme at ADA University." The attendees included representatives of local universities, academia, state agencies as well as the students, staff and faculty of ADA University. A number of international guest speakers were invited: Andres Bassols from EU External Action Service, Brussels, Jonas Urbanavicius from the Kaunas University of Technology, Lithuania, Elena Korosteleva from University of Kent, UK, and Tamara Shashikina from European Studies Institute of MGIMO University, Russia. In a format of a workshop, the speakers shared

their experiences in the establishment of the EU Studies programme in their respective countries and discussed the prospects and challenges in instituting the programme in Azerbaijan.

Eurovillage - 2016

On 1 October 2016 the Center of Excellence in EU Studies took part in the annual Eurovillage festival organized by the EU Delegation in Azerbaijan. The one-day festival took place on the Boulevard and welcomed locals and foreigners with



entertainment, food and music. Visitors learned about the Center's activities and programs and participated in the EU trivia lottery. All participants were awarded with gifts. The winners of the EU Art Contest were also presented with certificates and gifts.

Conference "Inter-Religious Tolerance and the Role of Social Media"



On 15 December 2016 the Center of Excellence in EU Studies at ADA University hosted a conference entitled "Inter-Religious Tolerance and the Role of Social Media". Malena Mard, EU Ambassador to Azerbaijan, Aflatun Amashov, Chair of

Azerbaijan Press Council, and Professor Roald Sagdeyev were amongst the distinguished speakers of the conference. The speakers discussed the influence of Azerbaijani social media on cultivating and enhancing inter-religious tolerance in the country as well as highlighting Azerbaijan's secular nature where representatives of various religious groups are respected and accepted.

Public lecture on single energy market and energy and law policies

On 17-18 November 2016 the Center hosted a two-day lecture by Dr. Sitaras, Deputy Ambassador of Greece in Azerbaijan. Dr. Sitaras, an energy security expert, lectured ADA students on the topics of single energy market and energy and law policies of
